RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS CONOVER, HOGAN, DICKINSON, THOMAS, BRUNO, MERLINO AND STROUGH

**AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT WITH EDWARD ZIBRO D/B/A
WARRENSBURG BIKE RALLY FOR USE OF THE WARREN
COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS FOR ANNUAL BIKE RALLY**

WHEREAS, Edward Zibro d/b/a Warrensburg Bike Rally is requesting an agreement with the County for use of the Warren County Fairgrounds property for the Warrensburg Bike Rally event held each year in late May or early June commencing in 2022, with an option to renew the agreement under the same, or substantially similar terms and conditions for a period of five (5) years, and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee recommends approving the requested agreement with Edward Zibro d/b/a Warrensburg Bike Rally for use of the Warren County Fairgrounds property at a rate of Two Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2,488.50) for the term commencing June 1, 2022 and terminating June 13, 2022, and allowing an option to renew the agreement under the same, or substantially similar terms and conditions, for a period of five (5) years with the annual amount of such agreement to be re-negotiated each year, contingent upon the annual assertion of the Superintendent of the Department of Public Works that the event does not cause a significant cost impact to the County and the annual concurrence from the Town of Warrensburg that they desire the event to continue to be held in their community, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Superintendent of the Department of Public Works to execute a County Fairgrounds Use Permit with Edward Zibro d/b/a Warrensburg Bike Rally to effectuate the terms of this resolution, for a term commencing June 1, 2022 and terminating June 13, 2022, for a total amount not to exceed Two Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2,488.50), and allowing an option to renew the agreement under the same, or substantially similar terms and conditions, for a period of five (5) years with the annual amount of such agreement to be re-negotiated each year, contingent upon the annual assertion of the Superintendent of the Department of Public Works that the event does not cause a significant cost impact to the County and the annual concurrence from the Town of Warrensburg that they desire the event to continue to be held in their community, in a form approved by the County Attorney.
