RESOLUTION No. 82 OF 2022

RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS CONOVER, HOGAN, DICKINSON, THOMAS, BRUNO, MERLINO AND STROUGH

AMENDING LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH REVOLUTION RAIL COMPANY FOR USE OF COUNTY OWNED RAILROAD TRACKS, TO INCLUDE USE OF AN ADDITIONAL PORTION OF THE TRACKS DURING THEIR RAIL JAM FESTIVAL EVENT

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 563 of 2021 the Warren County Board of Supervisors authorized the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute a license agreement with Revolution Rail Company, 3 Railroad Place, North Creek, New York 12853, for use of County owned railroad tracks, for a term commencing January 1, 2022 and terminating December 31, 2022, for an amount of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000) and an additional Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) per station, per month for use of the Hadley and Thurman Rail Stations, and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee has approved a request to amend the agreement to include use of the railroad tracks from mile post 68 to mile post 95 (North Creek Station) during their Rail Jam Festival Event commencing on June 12, 2022 and terminating on June 25, 2022, at no additional cost, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an amendment agreement with Revolution Rail Company to include use of the railroad tracks from mile post 68 to mile post 95 (North Creek Station) during their Rail Jam Festival Event commencing on June 12, 2022 and terminating on June 25, 2022, at no additional cost, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that other than the changes outlined herein, all other terms and conditions of Resolution No. 563 of 2021 will remain the same.
