RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS THOMAS, CONOVER, BEATY, FRASIER, WILD, BRAYMER AND RUNYON

AUTHORIZING CALL IN RATE FOR THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND PATIENT SERVICES AND ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC HEALTH

AMENDED FROM THE FLOOR

WHEREAS, due to the ongoing duties and responsibilities created by the COVID-19 pandemic the Director of Public Health and Patient Services and Assistant Director of Public Health have been required and shall be required to perform work of an extraordinary nature outside the regular and anticipated scope of their employment for the County and beyond the regular work days and hours established for their positions, and

WHEREAS, the Personnel, Administration & Higher Education Committee approved a call in rate for Saturdays and Sundays for the Director of Public Health and Patient Services and Assistant Director of Public Health, in the fixed amount of Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350) per day, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Health and Patient Services shall obtain prior approval for call in work on Saturdays or Sundays, effective February 18, 2022, from either the County Administrator or the Chair of the Health Services Committee prior to beginning such work, and the Assistant Director of Public Health shall obtain prior approval for call in work on Saturdays or Sundays, effective February 18, 2022, from the Director of Public Health and Patient Services prior to beginning such work, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Health and Patient Services and the Assistant Director of Public Health shall punch in with Novatime at the beginning of all call in work when working in office and shall use the remote punch in when working remotely, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby approves a call in rate for the Director of Public Health and Patient Services and Assistant Director of Public Health, in the fixed amount of Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350) per day, upon the conditions set forth in the preambles of this resolution.
