WHEREAS, the invasion of Ukraine and attacks against its people have been broadly condemned by United States President Joseph Biden, leadership of the European Union and numerous other countries around the world, and


WHEREAS, Warren County and the Capital Region are home to a robust and thriving community of Ukrainian immigrants and their family members, and
