RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS FRASIER, MCDEVITT, HOGAN, BRAYMER, CONOVER, BEATY AND GERACI

AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT WITH TRI-COUNTY UNITED WAY TO PROVIDE MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION TO RESIDENTS OF WARREN COUNTY WHO ARE 60(+) YEARS OF AGE FOR THE OFFICE FOR THE AGING

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to enter into an agreement with Tri-County United Way, 696 Upper Glen Street, Queensbury, New York 12804, to provide medical transportation to residents of Warren County who are 60(+) years of age under the Community Services for the Elderly (CSE) program, for a term commencing April 1, 2022 and terminating March 31, 2023, with the option to automatically renew the agreement for one (1) year terms, upon mutual agreement of the parties, at an hourly rate of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) each for a one way trip, 25 miles or less and Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) each for a one way trip between 26-50 miles, for an total amount not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) per year, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the funds shall be expended from Budget Code A.6772 470 OFA-Warren County, Contract.
