RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS BRAYMER, DICKINSON, SEEBER, THOMAS, BEATY AND WILD; AND COMMITTEE MEMBERS LAMOTHE, AGNEW, GILLES, BITTEL, MOORE, SWAN AND GADDY

AUTHORIZING ALLOCATION OF ARPA FUNDING TO VARIOUS COUNTY AGENCIES IN WARREN COUNTY

WHEREAS, the United States Treasury adopted a final rule implementing Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds established under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), and

WHEREAS, Warren County was awarded Twelve Million Four Hundred Twenty Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-Two Dollars (\$12,420,372) in ARPA funding to be allocated as permitted under the United States Treasury's final rule, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the allocation of ARPA funds in an amount not to exceed One Million Five Hundred Eighty-One Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Seven Dollars (\$1,581,637) to the following County agencies:

Employment & Training Administration	Purchase of laptop computers and tablets to be borrowed by job seekers throughout Warren County for the purpose of working on resumes, job searches, online job applications and to attend virtual employment related workshops and classes	\$30,000.00
Various County Agencies	Reimbursement for equipment replacement costs (Resolution No. 453 of 2021)	\$251,580.00
Warren County (Floyd Bennett Memorial) Airport	Reimburse expenses for escalated material costs related to the construction of the Snow Removal Equipment Building	\$100,057.00
Various County Agencies	Technology needs to improve County governmental resiliency	\$250,000.00
Countryside Adult Home	Capital Improvements including HVAC upgrades	\$950,000.00
