**RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS MERLINO, DICKINSON, MAGOWAN AND HOGAN
(ALTERNATE COUNTY MEMBER - SUPERVISOR FRASIER)**

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 98 OF 2022, "AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM DEFERRED REVENUE-GASLIGHT VILLAGE PARKING FEES TO CHARLES R. WOOD PART, REPAIRS AND MAINT-BLDG/PROPERTY; AUTHORIZING REIMBURSEMENT TO THE VILLAGE OF LAKE GEORGE FOR VARIOUS EXPENSES; AND AMENDING 2022 WARREN COUNTY BUDGET," TO REMOVE LANGUAGE AUTHORIZING A BUDGET AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 98 of 2022, the Warren County Board of Supervisors approved the appropriation of funds in an amount not to exceed Three Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-Six Dollars and Eighty-Six Cents (\$3,396.86) from the Deferred Revenue-Gaslight Village Parking Fees (A.691.07) to Budget Code A.1625 413 Charles R. Wood Park, Repairs and Maint-Bldg/Property for September 2021 parking attendants and gas associated with the Festival Space of the Charles R. Wood Park and to amend the Warren County Budget for 2022, and

WHEREAS, the Park Operations & Management Committee has approved a request to remove the language authorizing a budget amendment as funds from the 2022 budget cannot be used to pay a 2021 invoice, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 98 of 2022 be, and hereby is, amended to remove the language authorizing a budget amendment, and be it further

RESOLVED, that other than the changes outlined herein, all other provisions of Resolution No. 98 of 2022 shall remain in full force and effect.
