RESOLUTION NO. 203 OF 2022

RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS LEGGETT, THOMAS, BRUNO, MERLINO, RUNYON, DIAMOND AND DRISCOLL

INCREASING CAPITAL PROJECT NO. H347, INVASIVE SPECIES BOAT WASHING STATIONS; AUTHORIZING TRANSFER OF FUNDS; AND AMENDING 2022 WARREN COUNTY BUDGET

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors does hereby increase Capital Project No. H347, Invasive Species Boat Washing Stations, as follows:

1. Capital Project No. H347, Invasive Species Boat Washing Stations is hereby increased in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars and Eighty-One Cents (\$256.81).
2. The estimated total cost of Capital Project No. H347, Invasive Species Boat Washing Stations is now Nine Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars and Eighty-One Cents (\$964,356.81).
3. The proposed method of financing the increase in such Capital Project consists of the following:
 - a. Local share funding in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars and Eighty-One Cents (\$256.81) shall be transferred from Budget Code A.9950 910 Transfers-Capital Projects, Interfund Transfers,

RESOLVED, that the Warren County budget for 2022 be, and hereby is, amended accordingly, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes and approves the County Treasurer to transfer the funds in the amount indicated below:
