AUTHORIZING MEMORANDUMS OF AGREEMENT WITH ALL OF THE WARREN COUNTY SHERIFF'S COLLECTIVE BARGAINING UNITS TO UPDATE THE EDUCATION REIMBURSEMENT POLICY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 458 of 2019, the Chair of the Board of Supervisors was authorized to execute a Collective Bargaining Agreement on behalf of the County of Warren with the Police Supervisors Benevolent Association, for a term commencing retroactive to January 1, 2018 and terminating December 31, 2022, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 629 of 2019, the Chair of the Board of Supervisors was authorized to execute a Collective Bargaining Agreement on behalf of the County of Warren with the Warren County Correctional Supervisors Association, for a term commencing January 1, 2020 and terminating December 31, 2022, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 338 of 2021, the Chair of the Board of Supervisors was authorized to execute a Collective Bargaining Agreement on behalf of the County of Warren with the Warren County Police Benevolent Association, for a term commencing January 1, 2020 and terminating December 31, 2022, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 339 of 2021, the Chair of the Board of Supervisors and the Warren County Sheriff were authorized to execute a Collective Bargaining Agreement on behalf of the County of Warren with the Warren County Sheriff's Employees' Alliance, for a term commencing January 1, 2021 and terminating December 31, 2024, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 500 of 2021, the Warren County Board of Supervisors adopted a procedure for reimbursement of costs associated with Employment Related Educational/Professional Training, Certification (including non-credit bearing certification programs) and Credit-bearing course work that provides benefits to Warren County, and
