RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS CONOVER, HOGAN, DICKINSON, THOMAS, BRUNO, MERLINO AND STROUGH

AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY SERVICES TO PROVIDE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT FUNDING FOR THE OLMSTEDVILLE ROAD (CR 19) OVER MARSHALL BROOK CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT, TOWN OF CHESTER

WHEREAS, the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services provides performance grant funding for hazard mitigation, and

WHEREAS, the Warren County Department of Public Works desires to obtain grant funding for the Olmstedville Road (CR 19) over Marshall Brook culvert replacement project in the Town of Chester, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute a grant application to the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services, 1220 Washington Avenue, Building 7A, 6th Floor, Albany, New York 12242, for Hazard Mitigation Grant funding, in an amount to be determined, for a term to be determined, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that upon notification of the grant award, the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be, and hereby is, authorized to execute the grant agreement(s), and any and all other necessary documents relating to said agreement, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that if any further funding becomes available during the term of this contract, no further resolution will be necessary to accept these funds and the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is authorized to execute any documents necessary to receive the funds.
