RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS FRASIER, MCDEVITT, HOGAN, BRAYMER, CONOVER, BEATY AND GERACI

AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT CONTINUING RELATIONSHIP WITH NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR FUNDING FOR RABIES PREVENTION RELATED ACTIVITIES INCLUDING OUTREACH, VACCINATION CLINICS AND RABIES POST EXPOSURE PROPHYLAXIS

RESOLVED, that Warren County continue the agreement with New York State Department of Health, Bureau of Communicable Disease Control, ESP Corning Tower, Room 651, Albany, New York 12237 (Contract #C3657GG), for funding for rabies prevention related activities including outreach, vaccination clinics and rabies post exposure prophylaxis in a total amount not to exceed Fifty-One Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty-Nine Dollars (\$51,759), for a multi-year term commencing April 1, 2022 and terminating March 31, 2025, with an initial term commencing April 1, 2022 and terminating March 31, 2023, said funding for the initial term, and each term after, will be in an amount not to exceed Seventeen Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-Three Dollars (\$17,253), and the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be, and hereby is, authorized to execute an agreement for the initial term in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be, and hereby is, authorized to execute the annual funding renewal agreements for such additional annual terms through March 31, 2025, contingent upon funding availability and program performance in a form approved by the County Attorney without the need for further resolution, and be it further

RESOLVED, that if any further funding becomes available during the term of this agreement, no further resolution to accept said monies is necessary and the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is authorized to execute any documents necessary to receive the additional funds, in a form approved by the County Attorney.
