RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS GERACI, BRAYMER, SEEBER, DICKINSON, DRISCOLL, MCDEVITT AND DIAMOND

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE BOLTON CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE WARREN COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO PROVIDE LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES AT THE BOLTON CENTRAL SCHOOL

WHEREAS, the Bolton Central School District ("School") has requested that the Warren County Sheriff provide law enforcement services by providing coverage equal to one (1) School Resource Officer in the form of either a Patrol Officer, Patrol Officer - Part Time, or a Special Patrol Officer, as determined by the Sheriff, at the Bolton Central School for the 2022-2023 academic year, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff has agreed to provide these services during normal school hours throughout the school calendar year and for such other school events that may be requested by the School District and covered under the terms of the agreement, and

WHEREAS, the School has agreed to pay the County an amount not to exceed Thirty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$38,000) per school year for such School Resource Officer services to the Bolton Central School, for a term being retroactive to the date of execution of the agreement by both parties and terminating upon completion of the 2022-2023 school year and renewable by each party, upon the same terms for two (2) additional one (1) year renewal periods, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to enter into an agreement with the Bolton Central School District, 26 Horicon Avenue, Bolton Landing, New York 12814 to provide law enforcement services during normal school hours throughout the school calendar year and for such other events as may be requested by the School District for an amount not to exceed Thirty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$38,000) per school year, for a term being retroactive to the date of execution by both parties and terminating upon completion of the 2022-2023 school year and renewable by each party, upon the same terms for two (2) additional one (1) year renewal periods, in a form approved by the County Attorney.
