RESOLUTION NO. 447 OF 2022

RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS GERACI, BRAYMER, SEEBER, DICKINSON, DRISCOLL, MCDEVITT AND DIAMOND

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE LAKE GEORGE CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE WARREN COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO PROVIDE LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES WITHIN THE LAKE GEORGE CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Lake George Central School District ("School") has requested that the Warren County Sheriff provide law enforcement services by providing coverage equal to one (1) School Resource Officer in the form of either a Patrol Officer, Patrol Officer - Part Time, or a Special Patrol Officer, as determined by the Sheriff, at the Lake George Elementary School and another at the Lake George Jr.-Sr. High School for the 2022-2023 academic year, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff has agreed to provide these services during normal school hours throughout the school calendar year and for such other events that may be requested by the School District and covered under the terms of the agreement, and

WHEREAS, the School has agreed to pay the County an amount not to exceed Seventy-Four Thousand Dollars (\$74,000) per school year for such School Resource Officers services to each of the two schools in the Lake George Central School District, for a term being retroactive to the date of execution of the agreement by both parties and terminating upon completion of the 2022-2023 school year and renewable by each party, upon the same terms for two (2) additional one (1) year renewal periods, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to enter into an agreement with the Lake George Central School District, 381 Canada Street, Lake George, New York 12845 to provide law enforcement services during normal school hours throughout the school calendar year and for such other events as may be requested by the School District for an amount not to exceed Seventy-Four Thousand Dollars (\$74,000) per school year, for a term being retroactive to the date of execution by both parties and terminating upon completion of the 2022-2023 school year and renewable by each party, upon the same terms for two (2) additional one (1) year renewal periods, in a form approved by the County Attorney.
