**AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF INDIGENT LEGAL SERVICES FOR FUNDING UNDER SECOND UPSTATE FAMILY DEFENSE (CHILD WELFARE) QUALITY IMPROVEMENT & CASELOAD REDUCTION GRANT FOR THE PUBLIC DEFENDER'S OFFICE**

WHEREAS, the Public Defender is requesting approval to submit an application to the New York State Office of Indigent Legal Services for the Second Upstate Family Defense (Child Welfare) Quality Improvement and Caseload Reduction grant for an amount to be determined, for a term commencing February 1, 2023 and terminating on a date to be determined, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an application to the New York State Office of Indigent Legal Services for the Second Upstate Family Defense (Child Welfare) Quality Improvement and Caseload Reduction grant for an amount to be determined, for a term commencing February 1, 2023 and terminating on a date to be determined, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that upon notification of the grant award the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be, and hereby is, authorized to execute the grant agreement as well as any modifications, and/or other necessary documents relative to the above described grant program, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that if any further funding becomes available during the term of this contract, no further resolution will be necessary to accept these funds and the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is authorized to execute any documents necessary to receive the funds, in a form approved by the County Attorney.
