RESOLUTION NO. 601 OF 2022

RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS DICKINSON AND STROUGH

WAIVING THE STANDING RULE OF THE BOARD RELATING TO THE REQUIREMENT THAT ALL RESOLUTIONS BE APPROVED THROUGH THE ESTABLISHED COMMITTEE STRUCTURE IN ADVANCE OF A BOARD MEETING IN ORDER TO ENTERTAIN A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING TENTATIVE BUDGET PROVIDING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CONDUCT OF COUNTY BUSINESS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 AND AUTHORIZING PUBLIC HEARING ON THE BUDGET

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 68 of 2022, later amended by Resolution No. 576 of 2022, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Rules of the Board, Section B(3) of which indicates that all resolutions must be approved through the established Committee structure in advance of a Board Meeting, and

WHEREAS, the Board has agreed to consider a resolution accepting tentative budget providing appropriations for the conduct of County business for the fiscal year 2023 and authorizing public hearing on the Budget, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors does hereby waive the Standing Rule of the Board relating to the requirements that all resolutions be approved through the established Committee structure in advance of a Board meeting in order to entertain the aforementioned resolution.
