**AMENDING AGREEMENT WITH MEDIATION MATTERS FOR RESTORATIVE PRACTICES TRAINING IN ASSOCIATION WITH THE Y-RECONNECTS GRANT FOR THE PROBATION DEPARTMENT, TO INCREASE THE NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 217 of 2022 the Chair of the Board of Supervisors was authorized to enter into an agreement with Mediation Matters, 10 North Russell Road, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Albany, New York 12206, in an amount not to exceed Six Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$6,100), for restorative practice training in association with the Y-ReConnects Grant, over a term commencing April 1, 2022 and terminating March 31, 2023, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice & Public Safety Committee has approved a request to amend the agreement to increase the not to exceed amount from Six Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$6,100) to Twenty-Five Thousand One Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars (\$25,155), now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an amendment agreement with Mediation Matters to increase the not to exceed amount from Six Thousand One Hundred (\$6,100) to Twenty-Five Thousand One Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars (\$25,155), in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, other than the changes outlined herein, all other terms and conditions of Resolution No. 217 of 2022 will remain the same.
