RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS THOMAS, CONOVER, BEATY, FRASIER, WILD, BRAYMER AND RUNYON

AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT WITH FITZGERALD MORRIS BAKER FIRTH, P.C. TO PROVIDE LEGAL SERVICES IN DEFENDING WARREN COUNTY AGAINST CHILD VICTIM ACT CLAIMS FILED BY JOSHUA ROUSE FOR THE COUNTY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, the County Attorney is requesting that the County enter into an agreement with FitzGerald Morris Baker Firth, P.C. ("FitzGerald"), 68 Warren Street, Glens Falls, New York 12801, to provide legal services in defending Warren County against Child Victim Act claims filed by Joshua Rouse, for a term commencing November 21, 2022 and terminating upon conclusion of the Supreme Court lawsuit, excluding any and all appeals, for an amount not to exceed Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000), FitzGerald will bill the County at the rate of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200) per hour for all attorney's time, and Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75) per hour for paralegal time or a mutually agreed upon flat fee for the particular matter at the time, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be, and hereby is authorized to execute an agreement with FitzGerald Morris Baker Firth, P.C., for the legal services described in the preambles of this resolution, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the funds for this agreement shall be expended from Budget Code A.1420 440, Law (County Attorney), Legal/Transcript Fees.
