**AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 500 OF 2022, WHICH AUTHORIZED ARPA FUNDS
DISBURSEMENT TO NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES (NACO),
TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE RECIPIENT**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 500 of 2022, the Warren County Board of Supervisors authorized ARPA funds disbursement to the National Association of Counties (NACo) to fund Mental Health First Aid training and seminars for fifteen individuals to be trained to train other municipal employees and Warren County residents in an amount not to exceed Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000), and

WHEREAS, the ARPA Committee has approved a request to change the recipient from National Association of Counties (NACo) to National Council for Community Behavioral Healthcare d/b/a National Council for Mental Wellbeing, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an ARPA agreement with National Council for Community Behavioral Healthcare d/b/a National Council for Mental Wellbeing, as outlined above, in an amount not to exceed Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000), in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that other than the changes outlined herein, all other terms and conditions of Resolution No. 500 of 2022 will remain the same.
