## RESOLUTION NO. 715 OF 2022

**RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS FRASIER, MCDEVITT, HOGAN, BRAYMER, CONOVER, BEATY AND GERACI**

**AMENDING AGREEMENT WITH GREATER ADIRONDACK HOME AIDES, INC. TO PROVIDE PARAPROFESSIONAL CARE SERVICES FOR THE CERTIFIED HOME HEALTH AGENCY (CHHA) AND LONG-TERM HOME HEALTH CARE (LTHHC) PROGRAMS, TO INCREASE THE NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 639 of 2013 (as amended by Resolution No. 298 of 2015) the Chair of the Board of Supervisors was authorized to enter into an agreement with Greater Adirondack Home Aides, Inc., 25 Willowbrook Road, Suite 4, Queensbury, New York 12804, to provide paraprofessional care services for the Certified Home Health Agency (CHHA) and Long-Term Home Health Care (LTHHC) Programs, at rates not to exceed those set forth below:

WHEREAS, the Health Services Committee has approved a request to amend the agreement to increase the not to exceed amount for Home Health Aides from Twenty-Five Dollars and Fifty-Four Cents (\$25.54) to Twenty-Eight Dollars (\$28.00), now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an amendment agreement with Greater Adirondack Home Aides, Inc. to increase the not to exceed amount for Home Health Aides from Twenty-Five Dollars and Fifty-Four Cents (\$25.54) to Twenty-Eight Dollars (\$28.00), for a term commencing January 1, 2023 and terminating December 31, 2023, which agreement shall automatically renew on an annual basis unless terminated upon thirty (30) days written notice by either party, and in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be, and hereby is, authorized to execute further amendment agreements with Greater Adirondack Home Aides, Inc. for aforesaid services, without the need for future resolutions as long as there is no more than a five percent (5%) annual rate increase, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that other than the above amendments, Resolution Nos. 639 of 2013 and 298 of 2015, shall remain in full force and effect.
