RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS FRASIER, MCDEVITT, HOGAN, BRAYMER, CONOVER, BEATY AND GERACI

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 231 OF 2022, WHICH AUTHORIZED AGREEMENTS WITH INTERESTED WARREN COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICTS, CAMPS AND AGENCIES SERVING THE K-12 POPULATION TO RECEIVE COVID-19 TESTING KITS, SUPPLIES, AND/OR EQUIPMENT APPROVED BY NEW YORK STATE ELC SCHOOL GRANT FUNDING AND PROVIDED AND/OR DISTRIBUTED BY WARREN COUNTY HEALTH SERVICES, TO INCLUDE NEW YORK STATE REGISTERED PRESCHOOLS AND DAY CARES WITHIN WARREN COUNTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 231 of 2022, the Warren County Board of Supervisors authorized agreements with interested Warren County school districts, camps and agencies serving the K-12 population to receive COVID-19 testing kits, supplies, and/or equipment approved by New York State ELC Grant funding and provided and/or distributed by Warren County Health Services, for a term commencing May 20, 2022 and automatically renewing on an annual basis so long as grant funding is provided or unless terminated upon thirty (30) days written notice, and

WHEREAS, the Health Services Committee has approved the request to include New York State registered preschools and day cares within Warren County, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute agreements with any New York State preschool and day care within Warren County, as described in the preambles of this resolution, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that other than the changes outlined herein, all other terms and conditions of Resolution No. 231 of 2022 will remain the same.
