RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS CONOVER, HOGAN, DICKINSON, THOMAS, BRUNO, MERLINO AND STROUGH

RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 295 OF 2022, WHICH AUTHORIZED THE IMPLEMENTATION, AND FUNDING IN THE FIRST INSTANCE 100% OF THE FEDERAL-AID AND STATE “MARCHISELLI” PROGRAM-AID ELIGIBLE COSTS, OF A TRANSPORTATION FEDERAL-AID PROJECT, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE FOR CR 7 OVER HALFWAY CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT, TOWN OF QUEENSBURY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 295 of 2022, the Warren County Board of Supervisors authorized the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute all necessary Agreements, certifications or reimbursement requests for Federal Aid and/or Marchiselli Aid on behalf of the County of Warren with the New York State Department of Transportation for funding for additional construction work for CR 7 over Halfway Creek Bridge Replacement, Town of Queensbury, in an amount not to exceed Six Hundred Six Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-Nine Dollars (\$606,299.00), and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Public Works has advised that the New York State Department of Transportation revised the source of funding, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby rescinds Resolution No. 295 of 2022.
