

QUESTION: DOES WARREN COUNTY NEED A PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM

- ✘ Currently provided by GGFT
- ✘ GGFT can no longer meet the public transportation requirements
- ✘ Warren County is not better equipped or staffed to assume GGFT responsibilities
- ✘ Municipal public transportation programs are difficult to run
- ✘ CDTA has been in operation since 1970 – well run – well respected
- ✘ DSS, Probation, Public Defender/Assigned Counsel, DA rely on public transportation
- ✘ Visitors, residents and businesses rely on public transportation – particularly in summer

BENEFITS:

- ✘ Continue much needed public transportation options
- ✘ CDTA is well run and has an elaborate transportation network in Capital District
- ✘ Current routes and services provided by GGFT will continue
- ✘ Technological enhancements
- ✘ Possible expanded service
- ✘ Connections to Saratoga and Albany

COST:

- ✘ 1/4 of one percent of all mortgage recording taxes over \$10,000
- ✘ Between \$800,000 and \$1.5 million
- ✘ Warren County has been collecting since 2008 for General Fund purposes
