Dear Mr. Hajos:

I am pleased to award the Up Yonda Farm Environmental Education Center a grant in the introductory amount of \$15,000.00 through the Zoos, Botanical Gardens & Aquaria Program (ZBGA). This grant is to be used for interpretation and care of your Natural Heritage Collection.

ZBGA grants are funded through an annual appropriation under the Environmental Protection Fund (EPF). The 2022-23 EPF budget, enacted by the Governor and State Legislature, provided \$20 million for the ZBGA program.

This is the second year of funding for the 2021-2026 ZBGA grants program which operates on a five-year grant cycle. There will be no need to submit a new application until 2026. Your organization's grant amount will be automatically renewed in each of the next three state fiscal years, resulting in a total award of \$60,000.00.

On behalf of Governor Hochul, I greatly appreciate the work that your organization is doing to advance the critical goal of educating New York residents and visitors about the diversity and beauty of the natural world by stewarding and interpreting living collections of plants and animals. Your organization plays a vital role in the quality of life and economic vitality of New York State.
