Mr. Driscoll called the meeting of the Human Services Committee to order at 9:48 a.m.

It was noted due to Denise DiResta, *Director, Veterans' Services*, being unable to attend the meeting, the Department Updates would be tabled until the next Committee meeting.

Motion was made by Mr. Strainer, seconded by Ms. Turner and carried unanimously to approve the minutes of the previous Human Services Committee meeting, subject to correction by the Clerk of the Board.

Copies of the Veterans' Services agenda were distributed; a copy of the agenda is on file with the minutes.

Privilege of the floor and public comments were called for, but there was no one wishing to speak.

The meeting commenced with review of the Action Agenda/New Business Items section of the Veterans' Services agenda, which consisted of a request to amend the 2024 Warren County Budget in the amount of \$30,000 to reflect receipt of funding from the Office for the Aging, as authorized by Resolution No. 208 of 2019, to support transportation services.

Motion was made by Mr. Wild, seconded by Ms. Runyon and carried unanimously to approve the request as outlined above and refer same to the Finance & Budget Committee. *A copy of the resolution request form is on file with the minutes.*

As there was no further business to come before the Human Services Committee, on motion made by Mr. Bruno, seconded by Mr. Wild and carried unanimously, Mr. Driscoll adjourned the meeting at 9:53 a.m.
