Mr. Merlino called the meeting of the Park Operations & Management (O&M) Committee to order at 11:22 a.m.

Motion was made by Mr. Bruno, seconded by Mayor Perry and carried by a unanimous vote of those present (*Messrs. Diamond and Magowan absent*) to approve the minutes of the previous Committee meeting, subject to correction by the Clerk of the Board.

Copies of the meeting agenda were distributed; a copy of the agenda is on file with the meeting minutes.

Privilege of the floor was called for, but there was no one wishing to speak.

The meeting commenced with review of the Park O & M agenda with the following Discussion Items being addressed:

1. Winter use update. Mayor Perry advised he was working with the Police Athletic League of Albany to use the light display previously erected in Washington Park to create a large walk through display stretching from Shepards Park to Wood Park. He said they also intended to include vendors and a synthetic ice rink in the Beach Road parking lot to introduce a winter event which would not be weather dependent. Mayor Perry apprised he hoped to make this a free event by using Occupancy Tax funding shared by the Town and Village of Lake George. Further information on the proposed event would be presented at future meeting.
2. 2025 Budget request.

Privilege of the Floor and Public Comment was called for, but there was no one wishing to speak.

As there was no further business to come before the Park Operations & Management Committee, on motion made by Mr. Bruno and seconded by Mayor Perry, Mr. Merlino declared the meeting adjourned at 11:28 a.m.
