Drag Queen Story Hour the Musical

With your help, we plan a \$50K production at the Wood Theater during PRIDE month in June of *Drag Queen Story Hour, the Musical*: a fun, family-friendly gay-pride satire about how banning LGBT books, flags and story hours polarizes small towns across America.

This year, Warren County made **national news** for closing a library, in *New York Times*, on NPR and *The National Desk*. So Warren County needs a media makeover, from threatening to welcoming, exclusive to inclusive, Hate to Joy.

But we also made good news, locally and state-wide, on our reading in Crandall Library: two front pages, in the *Post Star* and *Times Union*. And the audience loved it: 87% said the music was “melodic and accessible, with a few outstanding numbers” and the lyrics “catchy, tight and fit the music perfectly.”

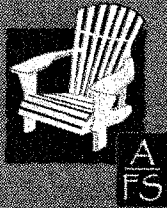
Warren County’s Anti-Discrimination Policy: **“Sexual harassment is strictly prohibited, on the basis of gender expression, when made a condition of employment, including vendors.”** But Jake Evans, the cancelled drag performer, lost his job due to his gender expression. And this isn’t just local.

Nationally, violent drag story hour protests like this happen 141 times a year, over READING TO KIDS. So, obviously -- I wrote a musical about it!

Zigzag and *Nearby Faraway*, grossed over \$100K two years ago, thanks to your generous grant. So you know we can create professional shows, pulling **34% from out of county**, by ticket zip codes. And *Drag Queen Story Hour* has a built-in audience of cultural tourists who spend money on lodging, dining & shopping: LGBT Groups from all over, who are interested in seeing it.

So we plan to double our PR budget to bring in PRIDE supporters from NYS and nationally, to help repair our media image. And Jake Evans, has agreed to come from Austin to show his support and attend, and maybe even to dance in it! Wouldn’t that make a national story Warren County could be proud of?

So, to conclude, which image of Warren County will bring in more tourists: **Bullies and Bigots with Bombs Won?** Or ***Drag Queen Story Hour, the Musical***, supporting gay pride and family-friendly free speech? Thanks.

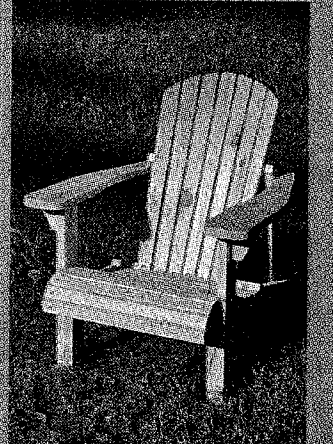
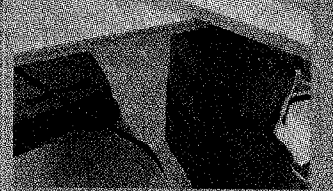
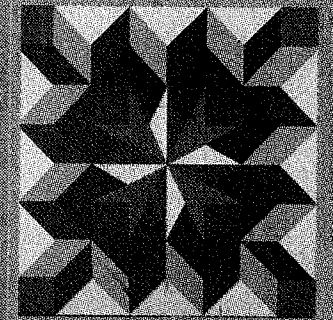
