## RESOLUTION No. 91 OF 2025

**RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS GERACI, CONOVER, MADAY, STRAINER, GILLIGAN, DRISCOLL AND PATCHETT**

**ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING FROM THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES FOR AID TO DEFENSE - SUPPLEMENTAL FOR THE ASSIGNED COUNSEL OFFICE**

WHEREAS, the Assigned Counsel Administrator requested, and the Criminal Justice, Public Safety & Emergency Services Committee agreed, to accept grant funding from the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services for Aid to Defense - Supplemental in an amount not to exceed Fifty Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars and Seventy-One Cents (\$50,562.71), to support public defense services and expenses incurred by government and not-for-profit entities, for a term commencing retroactive to April 1, 2023 and terminating March 31, 2025, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute any documents necessary to accept grant funding from the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services, 80 South Swan Street, Albany, New York 12210, for Aid to Defense - Supplemental in an amount not to exceed Fifty Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars and Seventy-One Cents (\$50,562.71), to support public defense services and expenses incurred by government and not-for-profit entities, for a term commencing retroactive to April 1, 2023 and terminating March 31, 2025, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that if additional State funding becomes available during the term of this grant, no further resolution will be necessary to accept the funds and the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is authorized to execute any documents necessary to receive the funds, and be it further

RESOLVED, that should the term of this grant be extended, the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute any related grant extensions, in a form approved by the County Attorney without the need for further Board resolution.
