RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS GERACI, CONOVER, MADAY, STRAINER, GILLIGAN, DRISCOLL AND PATCHETT

AUTHORIZING INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT WITH LAKE GEORGE PARK COMMISSION FOR ROUTINE SERVICE, EMERGENCY REPAIRS AND REPLACEMENT PARTS FOR THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE VESSELS, AND PROVIDING AUTHORIZATION FOR THE COUNTY TO PURCHASE FUEL FROM A RESPONSIBLE/PREFERRED VENDOR AND TO REIMBURSE/REPLACE THE FUEL USED BY THE WARREN COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, the Sheriff requested, and the Criminal Justice, Public Safety & Emergency Services Committee agreed, to enter into an intermunicipal agreement with the Lake George Park Commission for routine service, emergency repair services and replacement parts for the Sheriff's Office vessels, with labor performed at the fixed rate of Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75) per hour and parts billed at the cost incurred by the State of New York, as well as to provide authorization for the County to purchase fuel from a responsible/preferred vendor and to reimburse/replace the fuel used by the Warren County Sheriff's Office, for a term commencing March 1, 2025 and terminating February 28, 2026, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an intermunicipal agreement with Lake George Park Commission, 75 Fort George Road, Lake George, New York 12845, for routine service, emergency repairs and replacement parts for the Sheriff's Office vessels, with labor costs not to exceed Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75) per hour and parts billed at the cost incurred by the State of New York, as well as to provide authorization for the County to purchase fuel from a responsible/preferred vendor and to reimburse/replace the fuel used by the Warren County Sheriff's Office, for a term commencing March 1, 2025 and terminating February 28, 2026, with the option for one additional one-year term upon the same terms and conditions, and upon the mutual agreement of the parties, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the funds for this agreement shall be expended from Budget Code A.3110 441, Sheriff's Law Enforcement, Auto-Supplies & Repair, and Budget Code A.3110 442, Sheriff's Law Enforcement, Automotive - Gas & Oil.
