## RESOLUTION NO. 106 OF 2025

**RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS ETU, STROUGH, BEAN, WILD, TURNER, CROCITTO AND DIAMOND**

**AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE CHAMPLAIN HUDSON POWER EXPRESS FOR THE GREEN ECONOMY FUND GRANT FUNDING TO COVER EXPENSES FOR A PILOT PROGRAM THAT WILL PROVIDE JOB TRAINING AND READINESS SKILLS FOR FORMERLY INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS TO OBTAIN LOCAL MANUFACTURING JOBS AND AUTHORIZING A GRANT AGREEMENT FOR SAME**

WHEREAS, the Director of Workforce Development requested, and the Economic Growth & Development Committee agreed, to execute a grant application to the Champlain Hudson Power Express, 600 Broadway, Albany, New York 12207, for the Green Economy Fund grant funding in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) to cover expenses for a pilot program that will provide job training and readiness skills for formerly incarcerated individuals to obtain local manufacturing jobs, for a term commencing June 1, 2025 and a termination date to be determined, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute and submit a grant application to the Champlain Hudson Power Express, 600 Broadway, Albany, New York 12207, for Green Economy Fund grant funding in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) to cover expenses for a pilot program that will provide job training and readiness skills for formerly incarcerated individuals to obtain local manufacturing jobs, for a term commencing June 1, 2025 with a termination date to be determined, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that upon notification of the grant award, the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be, and hereby is, authorized to execute the grant agreement(s), and any and all other necessary documents relating to said grant agreement, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that if any further funding becomes available during the term of this grant agreement, no further resolution will be necessary to accept these funds and the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is authorized to execute any documents necessary to receive the funds, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that should the term of this grant be extended, the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute any related grant extensions, in a form approved by the County Attorney, without the need for further Board resolution.
