RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS DRISCOLL, BRUNO, PATCHETT, TURNER, WILD, STRAINER AND RUNYON

**APPROVING INTENT TO USE THE VACANT COUNTY OWNED BUILDING
(BUILDING #11) ON GURNEY LANE AS A FAMILY SHELTER**

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Social Services requested, and the Human Services Committee agreed, to approve of the intent to use the vacant County-owned building (Building #11) on Gurney Lane as a family shelter for up to thirty (30) years and that the Department of Social Services should proceed with a request for proposals (RFP) to identify a qualified service provider which will operate the shelter as well as develop funding strategies, conduct a building assessment for potential renovations and provide a time line for same, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby approves of the intent to use the vacant County-owned building (Building #11) on Gurney Lane for the proposed family shelter for up to thirty (30) years, and that the Department of Social Services shall proceed with an RFP to identify a qualified service provider which will operate the shelter as well as develop funding strategies, conduct a building assessment for potential renovations and provide a time line for same.
