## RESOLUTION NO. 168 OF 2025

RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS THOMAS, GERACI, STROUGH, MADAY, DRISCOLL, CROCITTO AND MERLINO

**AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL OTHER RESTRICTED-OPIOID (RESTRICTED) FUND BALANCE AND GENERAL OTHER RESTRICTED-OPIOID (UNRESTRICTED) FUND BALANCE TO THE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY SERVICES/MENTAL HEALTH BUDGET TO COVER THE COST OF EXPENDITURES OF OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUNDS TO ADDRESS THE IMPACTS OF THE OPIOID CRISIS IN WARREN COUNTY; AND AMENDING 2025 WARREN COUNTY BUDGET**

WHEREAS, the Director of Community Services requested, and the Finance & Budget Committee agreed, to appropriate funds to cover the cost of expenditures of opioid settlement funds to address the impacts of the opioid crisis in Warren County, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the appropriation of funds in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Sixty-One Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Three Dollars (\$361,123.00) from the General Other Restricted-Opioid (Restricted) Fund Balance (A.900.01) and One Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Twelve Dollars (\$129,912) from the General Other Restricted-Opioid (Unrestricted) Fund Balance (A.900.02) to the following budget codes to cover the cost of expenditures of opioid settlement funds to address the impacts of the opioid crisis in Warren County:
