RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS ETU, STROUGH, BEAN, WILD, TURNER, CROCITTO AND DIAMOND

AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF STATE OFFICE OF PLANNING, DEVELOPMENT & COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE FOR BOND ACT FUNDING THROUGH THE CLEAN WATER, CLEAN AIR AND GREEN JOBS ENVIRONMENTAL BOND ACT OF 2022 TO IMPLEMENT COASTAL REHABILITATION AND RESILIENCE PROJECTS WITHIN WARREN COUNTY

WHEREAS, the County Planner requested, and the Economic Growth & Development Committee agreed, to submit an application to New York State Department of State Office of Planning, Development & Community Infrastructure for Bond Act grant funding through the Clean Water, Clean Air and Green Jobs Environmental Bond Act of 2022 to implement Coastal Rehabilitation and Resilience projects within Warren County, in an amount not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000), intended for projects that support or are inspired by nature or natural processes and also offer environmental, economic, and social benefits while increasing resilience in Warren County, which shall be subject to a Two Hundred Thousand Dollar (\$200,000) local match, with the term of the grant to be determined, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an application with New York State Department of State Office of Planning, Development, & Community Infrastructure, 99 Washington Avenue, Suite 1010, Albany, New York 12231, for Bond Act funding in an amount not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000), intended for projects that support or are inspired by nature or natural processes and also offer environmental, economic, and social benefits while increasing resilience in Warren County, which shall be subject to a Two Hundred Thousand Dollar (\$200,000) local match, with the term of the grant to be determined, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Planner shall seek further approval to accept the grant and to designate the source of funds for the Two Hundred Thousand Dollar (\$200,000) local match required upon notification of a grant award.
