RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS GERACI, CONOVER, MADAY, STRAINER, GILLIGAN, DRISCOLL AND PATCHETT

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 32 OF 2024, WHICH AUTHORIZED AN AGREEMENT WITH MOUNTAIN MEDICAL SERVICES, PLLC TO PROVIDE SPECIAL PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS FOR HAZMAT TEAM MEMBERS WORKING WITH THE OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES, TO INCREASE FEES FOR PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 32 of 2024, the Warren County Board of Supervisors authorized an amendment agreement (previously authorized by Resolution Nos. 110 of 2019, 420 of 2019 and 32 of 2024) with Mountain Medical Services to provide the required hazardous materials team annual medical examinations, in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250) per physical, for a term commencing upon execution by both parties and terminating upon sixty (60) days written notice by either party, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Services requested, and the Criminal Justice, Public Safety & Emergency Services Committee agreed, to amend the agreement to increase the rate for each annual medical examination from Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250) per physical to Two Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$260) per physical, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an amendment agreement with Mountain Medical Services, PLLC, P.O. Box 13395, Belfast, Maine 04915 to increase the rates for annual medical examinations to Two Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$260) per physical, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, other than the amendment outlined herein, all other terms and conditions of Resolution Nos. 110 of 2019, 420 of 2019 and 32 of 2024 will remain the same.
