**WHEREAS**, at the behest of U.S. Representative Bella Abzug (D-NY) in 1971, and passed in 1973, the U.S. Congress designated August 26<sup>th</sup> as Women's Equality Day to commemorate the 1920 certification of the 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment to the Constitution, granting women the right to vote, and


**WHEREAS**, recognizing Women's Equality Day as a day of celebration throughout the Country emphasizes the importance of women's work for democracy, now, therefore, be it
