RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS STRAINER, RUNYON, GILLIGAN, BRUNO, PATCHETT, WILD AND THOMAS

AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS WITH VARIOUS AGENCIES TO IMPLEMENT PROJECTS AND SERVICES TO ADDRESS THE IMPACTS OF THE OPIOID EPIDEMIC IN WARREN COUNTY

WHEREAS, that Director of Community Services requested, and the Health Services Committee agreed, to authorize agreements with various agencies to implement projects and services to address the impacts of the opioid epidemic in Warren County, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute agreements with various agencies to implement projects and services to address the impacts of the opioid epidemic in Warren County, for a term commencing August 18, 2025 and terminating December 31, 2026, to be paid in a lump sum or in advance on a quarterly basis, for the amounts not to exceed those set forth in the attached Schedule "A," in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the funds for said agreement shall be expended from Budget Code A.4310.0176 470, Mental Health Admin., Opioid Settlement - Restricted, Contract.
