RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS STRAINER, RUNYON, GILLIGAN, BRUNO, PATCHETT, WILD AND THOMAS

AUTHORIZING A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE WARREN COUNTY OFFICE OF COMMUNITY SERVICES AND THE WARREN COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO FACILITATE THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF ADDICTION SERVICES AND SUPPORTS DESIGNATED FOR THE PURCHASE OF NALTREXONE AND BUPRENORPHINE FOR THE PURPOSE OF TREATING INDIVIDUALS THAT ARE INCARCERATED AT THE WARREN COUNTY CORRECTIONAL FACILITY

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Addiction Services and Supports has awarded the Warren County Office of Community Services Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-Nine Dollars (\$14,559) annually for two (2) years beginning July 1, 2025 to pay for all FDA approved formulations of naltrexone and buprenorphine for the purpose of treating individuals that are incarcerated at the Warren County Correctional Facility who have an opioid use disorder, and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Office of Community Services requested, and the Health Services Committee agreed, to enter into a memorandum of agreement with the Warren County Sheriff's Office to facilitate the expenditure of funds received from the New York State Office of Addiction Services and Supports to purchase naltrexone and buprenorphine for the purpose of treating individuals that are incarcerated at the Warren County Correctional Facility who have an opioid use disorder, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute a memorandum of agreement between the Warren County Office of Community Services and the Warren County Sheriff's Office to facilitate the expenditure of funds received from the New York State Office of Addiction Services and Supports, in the amount of Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-Nine Dollars (\$14,559) annually, to purchase naltrexone and buprenorphine for the purpose of treating individuals that are incarcerated at the Warren County Correctional Facility who have an opioid use disorder, for a term commencing July 1, 2025 and terminating June 30, 2027, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the funds for said agreement shall be expended from Budget Code A.4310 435, Mental Health Admin., Medical Fees.
