RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS WILD, DRISCOLL, ETU, MADAY, BEAN, PATCHETT AND MERLINO

RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 73 OF 2020, WHICH AUTHORIZED THE USE OF PAID ADMINISTRATIVE LEAVE IN THE EVENT OF A MEDICAL QUARANTINE FOR DISEASE PREVENTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 73 of 2020, the Warren County Board of Supervisors authorized the use of paid administrative leave in the event a county employee has been quarantined by a public health agency, in the interest of disease prevention, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Human Resources requested, and the Personnel, Administration & Higher Education Committee agreed, to rescind Resolution No. 73 of 2020 due to the fact that the New York State requirement for paid COVID-19 leave ended on July 31, 2025, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby rescinds Resolution No. 73 of 2025, to be effective August 15, 2025.
