RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS ETU, STROUGH, BEAN, WILD, TURNER, CROCITTO AND DIAMOND

AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION FOR ADIRONDACK PARK AND CATSKILL PARK COMMUNITY SMART GROWTH PROGRAM GRANT FUNDING TO SUPPORT LOCAL COMPREHENSIVE PLANS, FIRST WILDERNESS, WARREN COUNTY 2040 AND OUTDOOR RECREATION ECONOMY STRATEGIC PLAN (ORESP) ON BEHALF OF THE PLANNING & COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the County Planner requested, and the Economic Growth & Development Committee agreed, to the submission of an application to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation for Adirondack Park and Catskill Park Community Smart Growth Program Grant funding to support local comprehensive plans, First Wilderness, Warren County 2040 and outdoor recreation economy strategic plan (ORESP), in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000) or Three Hundred Dollars (\$300,000), with a sliding scale local share amount to be determined based on the grant award, and the term of the grant to be determined, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute and submit an application to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, 625 Broadway, Albany, New York 12233, for Adirondack Park and Catskill Park Community Smart Growth Program Grant funding to support local comprehensive plans, First Wilderness, Warren County 2040 and outdoor recreation economy strategic plan (ORESP), in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000) or Three Hundred Dollars (\$300,000) with a sliding scale local share amount to be determined based on the grant award, and the term of the grant to be determined, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Planner shall seek further approval to accept the grant, and to designate the source of funding for any local share required, upon notification of a grant award.
