RESOLUTION NO. 368 OF 2025

RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS STROUGH, CONOVER, WILD, DRISCOLL, MADAY, GERACI AND THOMAS

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 464 OF 2022, WHICH AUTHORIZED APPORTIONMENT OF EXPENSES RELATED TO THE CARE, CUSTODY AND CONTROL BY THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS OF VOTING MACHINES IN EACH ELECTION DISTRICT TO MUNICIPALITIES IN THE COUNTY, TO INCREASE ELECTION SERVICE FEES TO THE CITY AND TOWNS

WHEREAS, pursuant to the implementation of the “Election Consolidation and Improvement Act of 2005” and the statutes contained in New York State Election Law §3-226, Warren County assumed responsibility for the care, custody and control of all voting machines, as well as the appliances and equipment relating to or used in the conduct of elections, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 464 of 2022 (previously amended by Resolution Nos. 599 of 2005 and 215 of 2017) was adopted by the Warren County Board of Supervisors and authorized the apportionment of expenses connected with elections and matters preliminary or relating thereto, to the municipalities in Warren County at the rates outlined in the attached Schedule “A,” and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Board of Elections have requested, and the Legislative, Rules & Governmental Operations Committee agreed, to increase the election service fees from a flat rate of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500) to the rates outlined in the attached Schedule “A,” commencing with the 2025 election, and be it further

RESOLVED, that other than the changes outlined herein, all other terms and conditions of Resolution No. 599 of 2025, 215 of 2017 and 464 of 2022 will remain the same.

Formula for Election Districts (ED)

- ED with 1000 Active voters or less - \$1,750
- ED with 1001 - 1500 Active voters - \$2,000
- ED with 1501 - 2000 Active voters - \$2,250
- ED with 2001 or more Active voters - \$2,500
