## RESOLUTION NO. 417 OF 2025

**RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS DRISCOLL, BRUNO, PATCHETT, TURNER, WILD, STRAINER AND RUNYON**

**AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT WITH THE OPEN DOOR MISSION FOR USE OF CODE BLUE SERVICES FOR THE COUNTY'S HOMELESS POPULATION DURING INCLEMENT WEATHER FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA) requires Warren County to implement a Code Blue Plan to ensure that individuals experiencing homelessness have access to shelter during periods of inclement weather, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Social Services requested, and the Human Services Committee agreed, to enter into an agreement with The Open Door Mission, in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Seventy Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty-Seven Dollars (\$270,757) to be reimbursed through the 2025-2026 allocation from New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA), for use of code blue services for the County's homeless population during inclement weather, for a term commencing October 1, 2025 and terminating September 30, 2026, with automatic annual renewals upon mutual agreement of the parties and no future County share in the expense, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an agreement with The Open Door Mission, 226 Warren Street, Glens Falls, New York 12801, in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Seventy Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty-Seven Dollars (\$270,757) to be reimbursed through the 2025-2026 allocation from New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA), for use of code blue services for the County's homeless population during inclement weather, for a term commencing October 1, 2025 and terminating September 30, 2026, with automatic annual renewals upon mutual agreement of the parties and no future County share in the expense, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the funds for said agreement shall be expended from Budget Code A.6010 470, Social Services, Contract.
