Mr. Strainer called the meeting of the Health Services Committee to order at 10:20 a.m.

Copies of the Office for the Aging agenda were distributed to those in attendance; a copy of the agenda is on file with the meeting minutes.

Motion was made by Ms. Runyon, seconded by Ms. Gilligan and carried by a unanimous vote of those present (*Mr. Bruno absent*) to approve the minutes from the previous Health Services Committee meeting, subject to correction by the Clerk of the Board.

Privilege of the floor and public comments were called for, but there was no one wishing to speak.

The Committee commenced with a review of the Action Agenda/New Business Items portion of the Office for the Aging agenda which included the following request:

1. To authorize submission of an application to the NYS Office for the Aging for NY Connects grant funding in an amount not to exceed \$224,678, with no local match, for the term commencing April 1, 2025 and terminating March 31, 2026, and authorizing the Chair of the Board to execute any resulting grant agreement for same.

Motion was made by Ms. Runyon, seconded by Ms. Gilligan and carried by a unanimous vote of those present (*Mr. Bruno absent*) to approve the request as presented and the necessary resolution was authorized for the July 18<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting. *A copy of the resolution request form is on file with the minutes.*

A review of the Discussion Items portion of the agenda proceeded with an overview of the following:

1. Aging Concerns Unite Us (ACUU) Conference June 23-25, 2025, \$905.00 for three individuals.

Privilege of the floor and public comments were called for:

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Supervisor Driscoll informed that he had received an email regarding farmers market coupons that were valued at \$25.00 for eligible seniors in Warren County and he asked everyone to share the information with others.

There being no further business to come before the Health Services Committee, on motion made by Ms. Runyon, seconded by Mr. Wild and carried by a unanimous vote of those present (*Mr. Bruno absent*), Mr. Strainer adjourned the meeting at 10:23 a.m.
