- (f) Purpose of Establishment: This funding will allow for improvments to the HVAC systems in the museum & auditorium, provide for emergency back up power for theses buildings and allow for improvemnts to the courtyard between the buildings. The museum has never been equiped with any climate control to protect the nearly three dozen original taxidermed specimens in its diaorama. The condition of many of these specimens requires replacement. The Auditorium would receive an HVAC upgrade as well. Currently, an undersized window mounted air conditioner is used for the building that hosts public and school programs and events. Lastly, some of the funding will be used to upgrade the courtyrad to make it more accessable and user friendly to the public.
