

Warren County Board of Supervisors Proclamation

WHEREAS, Radon is a naturally occurring, colorless, odorless gas that occurs from decay of certain minerals, and

WHEREAS, Radon is also radioactive, which makes it hazardous to humans, and it is singled out as the second leading cause of lung cancer among Americans, responsible for as many as 20,000 deaths a year, and

WHEREAS, Radon can seep into homes and workplaces from subterranean sources, creating a risk of lung cancer from indoor air, and

WHEREAS, More than half of NY counties have been found to have higher risk of radon exposure in homes, based on the topography and landscape, and

WHEREAS, Despite the fact it is a toxin, radon can easily be remediated in a home setting once it is determined that it is present, and


WHEREAS, Federal guidance for determining radon exposure and risks can be found at www.epa.gov/radon, now therefore, be it
