RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS BRUNO AND GILLIGAN

AUTHORIZING LIMITED WAIVER OF ATTORNEY-CLIENT PRIVILEGE AND ATTORNEY WORK PRODUCT CONCERNING OCTOBER 23, 2025 WORKING SUB-GROUP MEETING OF THE RISK AND SAFETY COMMITTEE REGARDING THE COUNTY'S WIRE TRANSFERS AND E-BANKING POLICY AND SUBSEQUENT EMAILS

WHEREAS, the County Attorney requests the limited waiver of the attorney-client communications privilege and the attorney work-product privilege on behalf of the County of Warren for the content of communications which occurred on October 23, 2025 during a working sub-group meeting of the Risk and Safety Committee (“Working Group Meeting”), to include emails sent after the meeting, for disclosure to the Warren County Sheriff’s Office (“Sheriff”) as part of an ongoing criminal investigation, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the limited waiver of the attorney-client communications privilege and the attorney work-product privilege on behalf of the County of Warren regarding the content of communications which occurred during and after the Working Group Meeting, only for the limited purpose of disclosure to the Sheriff as part of an ongoing criminal investigation, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors finds that the limited waiver and disclosure approved herein, serves a legitimate governmental purpose and that cooperation with law enforcement is in the best interests of Warren County, and it is further

RESOLVED, that County officers and employees that participated in the Working Group Meeting are hereby authorized to disclose attorney-client communications which occurred during the Working Group Meeting only to the Sheriff as part of an ongoing criminal investigation, and, it is further

RESOLVED, that County officers and employees are authorized to release documents, to include emails and attachments, otherwise protected by the attorney-client communications privilege and the

attorney work product privilege that were sent after the Working Group Meeting regarding the subject matter of such meeting only to the Sheriff, as part of an ongoing criminal investigation, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby reserves the right to assert the attorney-client communications privilege and attorney work product privilege in all subsequent proceedings in which the law permits privilege to be invoked on behalf of the County of Warren regarding the content of communications which occurred during and after the Working Group Meeting, to include documents and emails.
