**RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS WILD, CROCITTO, BRUNO, PATCHETT, DIAMOND, BEATY AND NILES**

**AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION FOR THE ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE GREEN JOBS FOR YOUTH GRANT FUNDING TO TRAIN YOUTH ON PROBATION FOR FUTURE JOBS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT**

### ***RESOLUTION WITHDRAWN***

WHEREAS, the Director of Workforce Development requested, and the Economic Growth & Development Committee agreed, to execute an application to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation for the Environmental Justice Green Jobs for Youth Grant funding in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000), with no matching County funds required, to train youth on probation for future jobs, for a term commencing September 26, 2026 and terminating September 30, 2029, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute and submit an application to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, 625 Broadway, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Albany, New York 12233, for the Environmental Justice Green Jobs for Youth Grant funding in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000), with no matching County funds required, to train youth on probation for future jobs, for a term commencing September 26, 2026 and terminating September 30, 2029, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that upon notification of the grant award, the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be, and hereby is, authorized to execute the grant agreement(s), and any and all other necessary documents relating to said grant agreement, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that if any additional funding becomes available during the term of this grant agreement, no further resolution will be necessary to accept the funds and the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is authorized to execute any documents necessary to receive the funds, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that should the term of this grant be extended, the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute any related grant extensions, in a form approved by the County Attorney without the need for further Board resolution.
