## RESOLUTION No. 69 OF 2026

**RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS CONOVER, STRAINER, BRUNO, DIAMOND, PATCHETT, NILES AND BEATY**

**AUTHORIZING AN INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN WARREN COUNTY AND THE WARREN COUNTY SOIL & WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT FOR MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEMS (MS4) ADMINISTRATION AND ADVISORY SERVICES AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS RELATING TO SAME**

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Public Works requested, and the Public Works Committee agreed, to enter into an intermunicipal agreement with the Warren County Soil & Water Conservation District in an amount not to exceed Twenty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$22,000) per year to provide Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) administration and advisory services over a term commencing upon execution by both parties and continuing unless terminated upon thirty (30) days written notice by either party, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute an intermunicipal agreement with the Warren County Soil & Water Conservation District in an amount not to exceed Twenty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$22,000) per year to provide Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) administration and advisory services over a term commencing upon execution by both parties and continuing unless terminated upon thirty (30) days written notice by either party, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be, and hereby is, authorized to execute any and all other necessary documents relating to said intermunicipal agreement, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the funds for said intermunicipal agreement shall be expended from the appropriate departmental budget code(s).
