RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS ETU, CROCITTO, CONOVER, MADAY, BRUNO, STROUGH AND RUNYON

**AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL OTHER RESTRICTED-OPIOID (RESTRICTED) FUND BALANCE AND GENERAL OTHER RESTRICTED-OPIOID (UNRESTRICTED) FUND BALANCE TO THE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY SERVICES/MENTAL HEALTH BUDGET TO COVER THE COST OF EXPENDITURES OF OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUNDS TO ADDRESS THE IMPACTS OF THE OPIOID CRISIS IN WARREN COUNTY;
AND AMENDING 2026 WARREN COUNTY BUDGET**

WHEREAS, the Director of Community Services requested, and the Finance & Budget Committee agreed, to appropriate funds to cover the cost of expenditures of opioid settlement funds to address the impacts of the opioid crisis in Warren County, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the appropriation of funds in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred Six Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-One Dollars (\$506,381.00) from the General Other Restricted-Opioid (Restricted) Fund Balance (A.900.01) and Two Hundred Eighty-Two Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Four Dollars (\$282,464) from the General Other Restricted-Opioid (Unrestricted) Fund Balance (A.900.02) to the following budget codes to cover the cost of expenditures of opioid settlement funds to address the impacts of the opioid crisis in Warren County:
