RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS TURNER AND RUNYON

WAIVING THE STANDING RULE OF THE BOARD RELATING TO THE REQUIREMENT THAT ALL RESOLUTIONS BE APPROVED THROUGH THE ESTABLISHED COMMITTEE STRUCTURE IN ADVANCE OF A BOARD MEETING IN ORDER TO ENTERTAIN A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATURE TO DESIGNATE THE BRIDGE IDENTIFIED AS BIN 1033550 LOCATED ON DIAMOND POINT ROAD AT EXIT 23 OF THE ADIRONDACK NORTHWAY (I-87) IN THE TOWN OF LAKE GEORGE AS THE “ECO STEPHEN L. RAYMOND MEMORIAL BRIDGE”

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 1 of 2026, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Rules of the Board, Section B(4) of which indicates that all resolutions must be approved through the established Committee structure in advance of a Board Meeting, and

WHEREAS, the Board has agreed to consider a resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to designate the bridge identified as Bin 1033550 located on Diamond Point Road at Exit 23 of the Adirondack Northway (I-87) in the Town of Lake George as the “ECO Stephen L. Raymond Memorial Bridge”, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors does hereby waive the Standing Rule of the Board relating to the requirements that all resolutions be approved through the established Committee structure in advance of a Board meeting in order to entertain the aforementioned resolution.
