Proclamation

WHEREAS, the Hon. Glens Falls City Judge Gary Hobbs has spent nearly 40 years in service to residents of Warren County serving as a jurist, prosecutor, attorney in private practice and volunteer for numerous organizations, and

WHEREAS, Judge Hobbs is retiring from the Glens Falls City Court bench after 22 years as of March 31, 2026, capping an illustrious career on the bench that saw numerous innovations that improved the local judicial system, and

WHEREAS, Judge Hobbs introduced or helped introduced numerous initiatives that bettered and streamlined the local court system, including courts that focused on providing drug treatment for those whose addictions played a part in their crimes; providing mental health treatment for those in need and bringing new innovations to try to address the cycle of domestic abuse with abusers, and

WHEREAS, Judge Hobbs helped create Warren County's Central Arraignment Part Court, which streamlines criminal court arraignments, resulting in better use of time for law enforcement, judges, defense attorneys and defendants, and helping cut travel costs, and


WHEREAS, in addition, Judge Hobbs served as an Acting County Court Judge, Acting Warren County Family Court Judge and supervising local court judge for the region, assisting and mentoring less experienced and non-attorney judges, and

WHEREAS, before he began his career as a jurist, Judge Hobbs worked as an Assistant District Attorney and Special Prosecutor for Warren County, overseeing prosecution of criminal cases seeking justice on behalf of the People of the State of New York, and

WHEREAS, when Judge Hobbs was not in a courtroom or law office, he could be found donating his time assisting local youth sports organizations, the Warren County and NY State bar associations and student mock trial competitions, so be it
