RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS STRAINER, GILLIGAN, BRUNO, MADAY, BUTLER, WILD AND O'NEILL

AUTHORIZING REIMBURSEMENT TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS WHO PROVIDE ROUND TRIP TRANSPORTATION FOR ELIGIBLE CHILDREN ATTENDING EARLY INTERVENTION (EI) AND COMMITTEE ON PRESCHOOL SPECIAL EDUCATION (CPSE) CENTER-BASED SERVICES PER CHILD FOR THE HEALTH SERVICES DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 385 of 2023, the Warren County Board of Supervisors authorized an agreement with Durrin, Inc. relative to Transportation for Preschool Children with Disabilities and Early Intervention Program in Warren County, NY (WC 42-23), for a term commencing September 1, 2023 and terminating August 31, 2024, with the option for four (4) additional one (1) year terms upon mutual agreement of the parties, and

WHEREAS, the Warren County Department of Public Health is responsible for administering both NYS mandated Early Intervention (EI) and Committee on Preschool Special Education (CPSE) programs, which includes transportation for eligible children to attend approved center-based services, and

WHEREAS, reimbursement to parents/guardians who provide round trip transportation for eligible children attending Early Intervention (EI) and Committee on Preschool Special Education (CPSE) programs will incentivize more families to provide their own round trip transportation reducing overall program costs with contracted vendors, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Health/Patient Services requested and the Health Services Committee agreed to provide reimbursement to parents/guardians who provide round trip transportation for eligible children, per day per child, attending Early Intervention (EI) and Committee on Preschool Special Education (CPSE) programs, for a term commencing April 6, 2026, at the following rates:

Miles	Rate
0-15 miles	\$20
15.1 - 30 miles	\$30
30.1 - 45 miles	\$40
45.1 - 60 miles	\$50
60.1+	\$60

*Round trip distance from home/primary residence to program attended now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the County Auditor to reimburse parents/guardians who provide round trip transportation for eligible children, per day per child, attending Early Intervention (EI) and Committee on Preschool Special Education (CPSE) programs at the rates described in the preambles of this resolution, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the funds shall be expended from the appropriate departmental budget code(s).
